Class of 2020 Graduation Caravan Procedures

The graduation caravan is designed to be a safe community-wide event celebrating the graduation of the Morrisville High School Class of 2020, with that in mind please review and adhere to the following procedures.

<u>Cars</u>

- Graduates and their families are invited to decorate their car in Blue and Gold and join the graduation caravan by arriving at Morrisville M/S HS by 6:30pm. If possible, the graduate should be seated on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- Everyone should remain in their car throughout the celebration.
- Due to limited available space within Robert Morris Stadium, renting large vehicles such as buses, limousines, and vans is not permitted.

<u>Arrival</u>

- There is a one car per graduate limit, please do not bring other cars or people to the M/S HS so that we may adhere to health and safety guidelines.
- Families are welcome to safely ride in the car with their graduate.
- Graduates should be wearing their caps and gowns.
- Please pull into the M/S HS side parking lot using the driveway and follow the car line to join the caravan by 6:30pm, it will depart promptly at 7pm.
- We will provide each graduate with two name cards upon your arrival, you will need to return these cards upon entering Robert Morris Stadium. These cards will allow us to determine the order of graduates in the caravan.

<u>Departure</u>

• The graduation caravan will leave the M/S HS promptly at 7pm.

Caravan Reminders

- Everyone should remain in their car at all times throughout the celebration.
- Cars are expected to adhere to all traffic laws and regulations, and are not permitted to cause traffic to stop.
- No one is permitted to ride in the bed of a truck or hang out the sunroof of a vehicle.

Robert Morris Stadium

- Everyone should remain in their cars at all times throughout the celebration.
- For health and safety purposes, no one other than M/S HS personnel and one car per graduate will be permitted entrance into the stadium.
- Each graduate's car will enter Robert Morris Stadium and drive onto the track to the RIGHT, following the track around to the flagpole allowing for all graduates to enter the stadium.
- As your car enters the stadium, you will be asked to return both name cards given to you when you arrived at the M/S HS.
- As you circle the track you will safely park and wait for the procession to begin.
- The caravan will circle the track again as the names of graduates are read aloud via the PA system.
- Graduate names will be read in order of entry using the name cards provided and cars should drive around the track and return to park.
- As the graduate's car drives in front of the booth, you will be asked to stop so that we may award your diploma.
- Once all of the cars have circled the track and returned to park, our Superintendent, Mr. Harris, and our President of the School Board of Directors, Mr. Miller, will officially award the diplomas to the Class of 2020 via the PA system.
- The caravan will drive one more lap around the track and safely exit Robert Morris Stadium to conclude the graduation caravan.

Caravan Route

- Exit Morrisville M/S HS and turn Right onto W Palmer St.
- Left onto Grandview Ave
- Left onto Barnsley Ave
- Left onto Barclay Ave
- Left onto Cox Ave
- Right onto W Palmer St
- Right onto N Harding Ave
- Left onto Clymer Ave
- Left onto N Lafayette Ave
- Right onto Hillcrest Ave
- Left onto Harper Ave
- Left onto W Hendrickson Ave
- Left into Robert Morris Stadium
