<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>Pol. 216</p>	<p>The Board recognizes that communication between school and home is a vital component in the growth and education of each student. The Board acknowledges the school's responsibility to keep parents/guardians informed of student welfare and academic progress.[</p>
<p>2. Authority</p> <p>24 P.S. 1531 24 P.S. 1532 22 PA Code 4.11 Pol.127</p>	<p>The Board directs that the district’s instructional program shall include a system of measuring all students’ academic progress.</p> <p>The Board directs the Superintendent to establish a system of reporting student progress that includes academic progress reports, grade reports, and parent/guardian conferences with teachers.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations for reporting student progress to parents/guardians.</p> <p>All appropriate staff members, as part of their professional responsibility, shall comply with the systems established for measuring and reporting student progress.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Various methods of reporting, appropriate to grade level and curriculum content, shall be utilized. ● Both student and parent/guardian shall receive ample warning of a pending grade of failure, or one that would adversely affect the student's academic status. ● Scheduling of parent-teacher conferences shall occur at times that ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents/guardians. ● Grade reports shall be issued at intervals of not less than 4 times a school year. ● Review and evaluation of methods of reporting student progress to parents/guardians shall be conducted on a periodic basis.
