<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board acknowledges the necessity for a system of computing grade point averages and class rank for secondary school students to inform students, parents/guardians and others of their relative academic placement among their peers.</p>
<p>2. Authority</p> <p>Pol. 216 24 P.S. 510</p>	<p>The Board authorizes a system of class rank, by grade point average, for students in grades 9-12. All students shall be ranked together.</p> <p>Class rank will be computed beginning in grade 9, and will be a cumulative grade point average for all high school years. Grade point average will be computed by multiplying quality points times credits, adding the products obtained for each course, and dividing the resulting sum by total credits.</p> <p>Any two (2) or more students whose computed grade point averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position will be determined by the number of students preceding and not by the rank of the proceeding person.</p> <p>A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on the student's record and transcripts and shall be subject to Board policy on release of student records.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations for computing grade point averages and assigning class rank to implement this policy.</p>
