PREGNANT/MARRIED STUDENTS</p> <p>No student, whether married or unmarried, who is otherwise eligible to attend the schools of this district shall be denied an educational program solely because of pregnancy, childbirth, pregnancy-related disabilities, or actual or potential parenthood.</p> <p>The Board reserves the right to require as a prerequisite for attendance in the regular classes and the extracurricular program of the schools that each pregnant student present to the Superintendent her physician's written statement that such activity will not be injurious to her health nor jeopardize her pregnancy.</p> <p>A student who is married must declare his/her marital status at the time of marriage or at the time of enrollment in the school.</p> <p>A pregnant student whose mental or physical condition prevents her from attending regular classes, when such condition is certified by a licensed physician, may be assigned to an alternate educational program.</p> <p>A student who has received an alternate educational program, for reasons associated with her pregnancy, shall be readmitted to the regular school program upon her request and the written statement of a physician that she is physically fit to do so.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the implementation of this policy.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
