	241. COLLEGE ATTENDANCE
1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 11.4, 11.8	Attendance at a college in lieu of the senior year is designed for students of academic ability who wish to complete their senior year of high school while at the same time begin their studies toward a college degree.
2. Guidelines	A high school diploma will be issued by School District of Borough of Morrisville and freshman college credit shall be granted by the cooperating institutions. In cooperation with the participating schools, students develop individual schedules designed to meet the graduation requirements of the home high school, participating colleges, and the student's individual interests.
	To qualify, a student must first be accepted by a college into its program and then receive a letter of permission from the building principal which will outline the courses the student needs to complete the high school graduation requirements.
	The costs of the program must be assumed by the student and his/her family in accordance with the college's requirements. Financial aid may be received from the various state, federal or private programs providing aid for college students. Students interested in this option shall work with guidance counselors in investigating the various programs available to them.
	After providing written documentation of his/her satisfactory completion of college work, a student will receive his/her diploma.
